

Alcohol – liquor licence

Do I need a liquor licence?

If alcohol is present at your event, you may need a liquor licence to be compliant with State Regulations. This applies for selling, supplying or BYO.

The Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation (VCGLR) will make the decision if a liquor licence is required. Contact them through this website link https://www.vcglr.vic.gov.au/contact-us or phone 1300182 457

How do I apply for a liquor licence

Applications for a liquor licence need to be made online directly to VCGLR https://www.vcglr.vic.gov.au/i-want/get-new-licence or phone 1300 182 457

What do I tel VCGLR when I enquire/apply?

- Provide a description of your event what it is, why you are holding it, when it is happening, where it will be held, how many attending and the times it will be occurring;
- Which community group/club you are producing the event for;
- Provide details on what alcohol will be present are you selling, will people be bringing their own, will you be giving it away or is it part of a fundraiser?
- How will the alcohol be served plastic, glass, cans;
- Upon application you will need to provide a plan of your proposed event site, including the areas where alcohol can be consumed. Information on how to do this can be found here:
